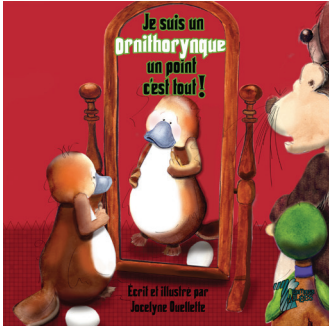

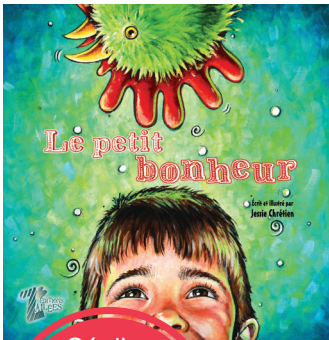
I am a Platypus and nothing else
