It'll Be the Biggest Bridge in the World!

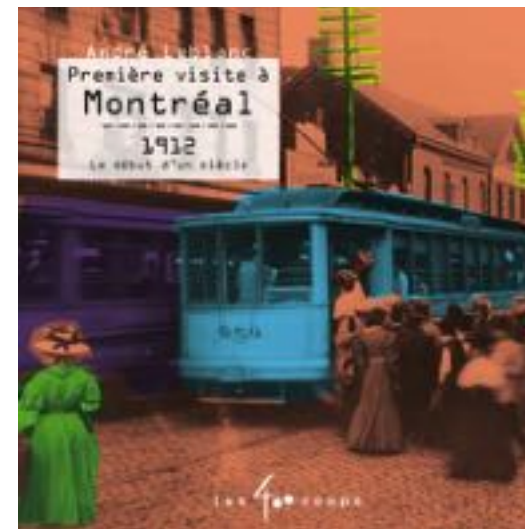
