





Dr. Squid, born on the KOI-7711 planet in the third solar system, becomes the chief researcher for "Restoration of Earth's life forms and research on new species for the future of the reset Earth." When the lights go out, the glowing inhabitants of Cosmo Villa depict the "history of extinction" they experienced on Earth.

By observing and listening closely to the mundane scene, the author uncovers a deer concealed among the paving stones and

notices the subtle relationship between a fox and a mouse. Though the path is familiar, it transforms into a world rich with stories.

After spring passes, summer naturally follows, and the heat of summer makes people's steps feel heavy and exhausted. However, couldn't the sluggishness brought on by the heat actually provide a sense of relaxation? The author invites us to change our perspective on the summer heat. Instead of viewing it as a burden, we can see it as an opportunity to slow down. The heat, in fact, seems to tell us to "pause for a moment," and the reason the trees have grown thick is to provide a shaded place for us to rest.

被联合国教科文组织列为世界非物质文化遗产 的韩国走绳技艺,不像其他国家那样仅仅展示 绳上的杂技表演,而是结合了绳上的表演者与 地面的小丑之间的诙谐对话以及三弦六角的演 奏,是一种综合艺术。将走绳技艺的这一特点 很好地融入到绘本中的本书展示了绳上表演者 在绳上穿行、腾空而起时那惊险的瞬间,并通 过简洁的视觉语言表现了三弦六角的演奏。

A picture book that sensorially captures the art of Korea's tightrope walking, a UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage. Unlike in other countries, Korean tightrope walking is a comprehensive art form, combining the tightrope performer's skills with witty banter exchanged with a clown and accompanied by traditional music. A Round of Tightrope Walking effectively conveys the tension of the performer's daring movements as if leaping through the air and the rhythm of the music through concise visual language, offering a unique experience of this traditional art.





这是一个讲述一个女生探索同班同 学金京熙无意中喃喃自语的"漂亮" 一词含义的故事。女孩从积极地审 视自己的外貌开始,逐步追寻"漂 亮"一词的含义。在这个过程中,女 孩不仅经历了细腻的情感变化,还 与对方产生了共鸣,寻找到这个词 背后真实的含义。女孩努力在自己 身上发现美,也从他人的评价中寻 找美,发现美就在自己身边,比如 说晚霞。作者李明爱用她温馨感人 的画作捕捉到了教室里平凡生活中 悄然流露的细腻情感。

This story follows a child who reflects on the meaning of the word "pretty" after hearing it casually from a class-

mate, Kim Kyung-hee. As the child explores the concept, they begin by examining their own appearance, then seek to understand its deeper meaning by empathizing with others. The narrative weaves through subtle emotional shifts, revealing how beauty can be found both within and around us. The author, Lee Myungae, captures these delicate emotions through warm illustrations of everyday classroom life.

Mom Wouldn't Know | Shim Eunji Selected for Bookstart in 2023.

因为妈妈感冒了,孩子不能去幼儿园,决定撸起袖子照顾妈妈。孩子担心妈妈会无聊,便在她身边堆了一大堆书;怕妈妈饿了,将自己爱吃的零食拿给妈妈;怕妈妈睡觉时觉得冷,在床上铺满了毛绒玩具。就像妈妈平时照顾生病的自己那样,孩子也尽心尽力地照顾着妈妈。孩子越是说"不要担心我",家里就变得越乱,但妈妈从孩子的真心中获得了力量。

When the child's mother catches a cold, the child decides to take care of her, eager to help. Worried that she might get bored, the child stacks a pile of books next to her, offers cherished snacks in case she gets hungry, and covers the bed with stuffed animals to keep her warm at night. Just like the mother had done for the child when sick, the child takes care of the mother with care. Though the house turns into chaos, the mother draws strength from the child's heartfelt efforts.

这是一部描绘母女之间看似不同却相似的日常生活以及她们之间快乐纽带关系的绘本。宥珍 迫不及待地想展示自己在幼儿园画的画,兴冲 冲地跑进家门,却被妈妈唠叨了一顿。宥珍逐 渐被妈妈的话压得喘不过气,身体缩小得像一颗小豆子。宥珍把这场唠叨的危机变成了机会,尽情玩耍,享受自由。被唠叨而变小的身体,成为了出口,反而让她躲过唠叨,获得了自由。

This picture book captures the bond between a mother and daughter, highlighting their seemingly different yet similar daily routines. Excited to show off her kindergarten drawing, Yujin runs home only to be met with a barrage of her mother's scolding. Feeling overwhelmed, Yujin begins to shrink until she's as small as a pea. However, she seizes this moment to turn the crisis into an opportunity, freely enjoying playtime and newfound independence as her tiny body escapes the scolding, transforming the experience into a liberating adventure.

这是一部以《丑小鸭》的故事为小主题的绘本,讲述的是三只看似极为普通的鸭子兄妹的故事,他们绝对不可能是丑小鸭。书中为那些"每天都在过着平凡日常"的小鸭子们,而不是那些"华丽变身成为天鹅"的少数人而喝彩。尽管在平凡的日子里,人们有时会在某一时刻成为非凡的存在,但他们又会回到日常生活中,珍惜平凡的生活。这是一个为无数这样的孩子们加油鼓劲的故事。

The story, inspired by The Ugly Duckling, centers on three ordinary ducklings who are far from the typical "ugly duckling" image. Instead of focusing on a rare transformation into a swan, the book celebrates the everyday lives of common ducklings. It encourages children to appreciate the beauty of daily life, acknowledging that while extraordinary moments may occur, the real value lies in treasuring the simplicity of ordinary life. It supports children who quietly live their lives with resilience and grace.

这是一个关于接纳多样性和少数群体的宽广胸怀的故事。这是一本感人至深的绘本,讲述了"另类的孩子"如何通过温暖的童心融入社会。生活在圆圈村的人们,脸和身体都是圆圆的,只有比尼的胸口像甜甜圈一样有个大洞。因为与众不同的外表而感到孤独得比尼,把有一个打洞的胸口藏了起来,并交到了朋友。故事讲述了纯真的善良与友情,温暖地包容了每个人心中想要隐藏的那一个弱点。

This story encourages the acceptance of diversity and minority identities through a heartwarming narrative. It tells the tale of Binnie, who lives in "Round Town" where everyone has round bodies and faces, except Binnie, whose chest is hollow like a donut. Feeling isolated due to this difference, Binnie hides the empty space and makes friends. The story highlights the importance of embracing personal vulnerabilities, and the kindness and friendship that can blossom from accepting one another's differences. It conveys a message of inclusion and understanding.

The winner of the 7th Sangsangmanbal Book Illustration Contest, Smile Today by Lee Yooiin, is a picture book that fondly looks back on the summer vacation memories of a granddaughter visiting her grandmother in the countryside. Together, they feed goats, eat watermelons cooled in a well, and catch fireflies, evoking the warmth of rural life. After breaking a sweat, they cool off by pouring water on their backs and then head out to catch dragonflies. While such scenes may be common in the countryside, they are seen as enviable by those in cities. This book helps readers recall the precious memories we may have lost.

After leaving the house, he discovers an invitation to a mysterious witch's restaurant. Eagerly, Hoon rushes to find out what magical dishes await him. The Witch's Restaurant is a picture book that uses whimsical food and fun characters to explore the themes of personal preferences and respect.

A Perfect Day captures how Teary deals with unexpected situations and learns that happiness isn't always about perfection but enjoying the journey itself.
