# ACCESSIBLE READERS: FICTION

**READING AGES:** The level the reader is reading at, regardless of actual age. This dictates the amount of copy on each page and complexity of sentence structure.

INTEREST AGES: The actual age of the reader. This dictates the topic choice (more friendly at the lower bands, more edgy at the higher bands) and complexity of vocab choices.

# CURRENT READING AGE PARAMETERS:

- Reading age 6 up to 30 words per page with simple sentences.
- Reading age 7 up to 40 words per page with simple sentences where possible.
