*The Famous Five* books, first published by Hachette 80 years ago, are among her most popular. She is also the author of other favourites including *The Secret Seven*, *The Magic Faraway Tree* and *Malory Towers*. These books encapsulate what readers love about Enid Blyton: adventure, friendship, heroism and page-turning storytelling.

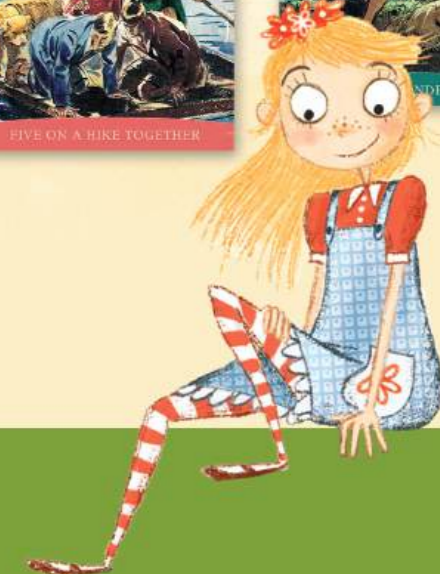
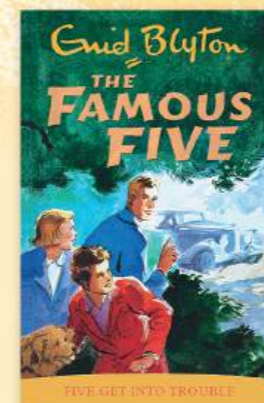
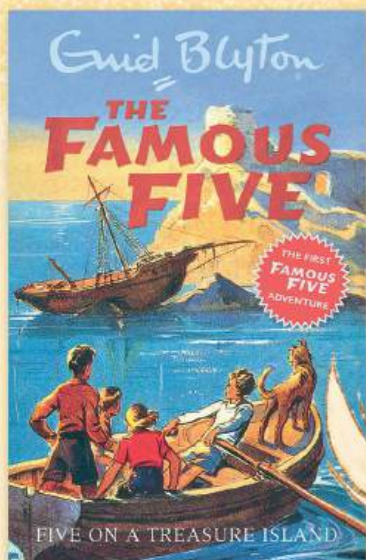
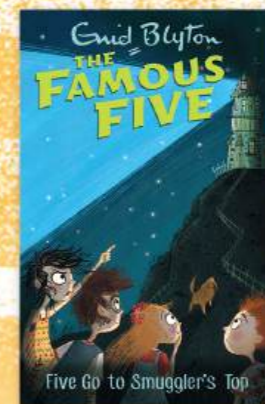
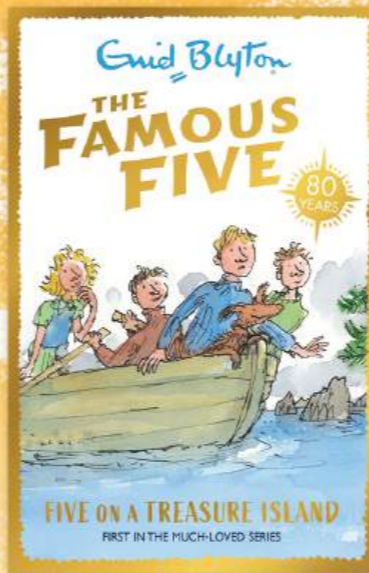




# THE FAMOUS FIVE
