Enid Blyton (1897–1968) is one of the most successful children's authors of all time. Her books have sold over 500 million copies and have been translated into other languages more often than any other children's author. She wrote over 700 books and about 2,000 short stories in a career spanning almost 50 years. Her work is loved by generations of readers across the world.

Born in London, Enid lived much of her life in Buckinghamshire and loved nature, animals and gardening. She was very knowledgeable about trees, flowers, birds and woodland life and used this to inform her stories.

The Famous Five books, first published by Hachette 80 years ago, are among her most popular. She is also the author of other favourites including *The Secret Seven*, *The Magic Faraway Tree* and *Malory Towers*. These books encapsulate what readers love about Enid Blyton: adventure, friendship, heroism and page-turning storytelling.
