Neural networks are inspired by the human brain. They are made up of layers of nodes that are connected to each other. Each node is like a neuron in the brain. The nodes in one layer are connected to the nodes in the next layer. This allows the network to learn from data and make predictions.

Neural networks are used in many different ways, such as:
 

- Image recognition (e.g. identifying objects in photos)
