The Turpan Karez Water System is an impressive hydraulic engineering project as well as a cultural achievement. Because the karez system has provided a safe and reliable water supply over 2000 years, the communities that rely on it have referred to it as the "mother river" and "spring of life." As the great irrigation project initiated by the ancient people, it is a great undertaking which benefits both the contemporaries and later generations.

This cheerful book offers an enticing introduction to the system that helped to make the Turpan area an oasis on the Silk Road route and make Turpan an important fruit and vegetable growing area.
